

## ***Student Body Profile***

- 49% of students live in single parent homes or with a guardian.
- 58% of students have dropped out of school or have not been continuously enrolled prior to coming to this school.
- 93% of students report a major emotional loss in their lives such as death of a friend or loved one.
- 53% of students have documented histories of personal drug or alcohol use or guardians with documented dependencies on drugs or alcohol.

"The physical and emotional health needs of these adolescents are often high, yet they are typically reluctant to seek help. School-based health centers eliminate barriers to health care. We provide students with quality, confidential treatment and preventive education that supports each individual's success and makes possible a brighter future."

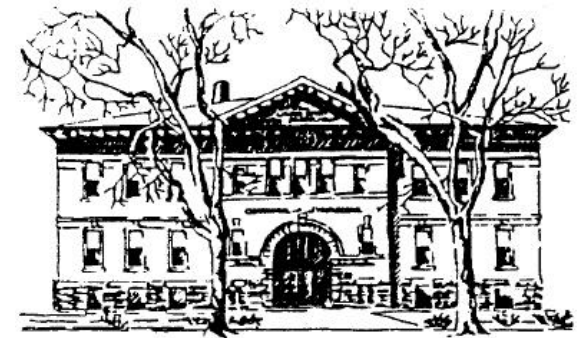
