I agree to the terms and responsibilities stated below in connection with obtaining authorization to use the school parking lot.

I understand that the parking lot is the property of Poudre School District. I agree that the vehicle driven will not be used to transport or store illegal items on school property. I agree that I will not use the school parking lot to violate a criminal code or school rule.

I understand and give school officials and/or Campus Security Officers consent to search the vehicle driven onto Poudre School District property and the vehicles contents at any time when it is parked on school property.

I authorize school officials and/or Campus Security Officers to seize any item that violates a criminal law or school rule or provides evidence of a criminal law or school rule violation.

STUDENT VEHICLE USE AND PARKING

BOARD POLICY: JLIE - STUDENT VEHICLE USE AND PARKING

When parking lots are provided on campus, all student-driven vehicles shall be parked in such lots. No vehicles may be driven on the school grounds except in designated parking area.

Student-driven vehicles shall remain parked while students are scheduled to be in class. No loitering in parked cars or on school parking lots shall be permitted during the school day.

Principals may make reasonable parking and driving regulations as necessary for the proper operation of their school programs.

BOARD POLICY: JIHB - PARKING LOT PRIVILEGES

The privilege of bringing a student-operated motor vehicle onto school premises is based upon the condition of consent by the student driver to allow a search of the vehicle when there is reasonable suspicion the search will yield evidence of contraband.

Refusal by a student, parent/guardian, or vehicle owner to allow search access to a motor vehicle on school premises when requested shall be cause for termination without further hearing of the privilege of bringing any vehicle onto school premises by said individual.

Routine patrolling of student parking lots, inspection of the outside of student automobiles, and the use of drug detection dogs in the school district parking lots shall be permitted at all times.

I certify that the above information is correct, and that I have read and understand Fort Collins High School's regulations and penalties related to parking and driving on campus. Failure to observe these regulations may result in revocation of the driving privilege and ticketing or towing of the vehicle. Fort Collins High School and/or Poudre School District is not responsible nor liable for theft or damage to vehicles on school property.
