1. Boundaries  
A review of the four proposals was discussed. Information is on the PSD website. The PSD committee has two more meetings, Dr. Wilson will seek community input and a decision will be made later in the spring.
2. Grade Configuration  
A review of the work done by the PSD committee was reviewed. Please check the PSD website for updates. The FRHS SIT will be working on the readiness plan in conjunction with staff. Dr. Cook will be visiting the feeder junior highs. The Curriculum Fair on January 28<sup>th</sup> will be a way to showcase the opportunities at FRHS.

4. Concerns:
  - a. Calculus BC can we offer it? Will we have enough students interested? Dr. Cook will follow up with FCHS and the FRHS math department.
  - b. INTEL class at FRHS. Dr. Cook checked with FCHS – the class is open to all high schools. This is a great opportunity for students who are interested in engineering.
  - c. Marketing FRHS. We need a trademark or unique recognition in the community. We are high achieving school with opportunities for engineering, art, music, etc. We need to work on how we will/can recruit students.
  - d. Parking and traffic in the lots at events and after school. Review of the safety need for the traffic pattern was discussed. Dr. Cook will ask PSD security to assist with the traffic and making sure that folks are following the one-ways.
