Topics Discussed:

Teacher 360 Survey's in December:

Students who have teachers on the evaluation cycle will be scheduled into computer time to do a short survey on their teachers. We are looking for honest and useful feedback to support the work of our teachers.

Senior Parking:

Student Council is involved with a process called RSVP which looks at issues within the school and how to make a difference. Issues that they are looking at include: DEAR, Advisory, Senior Parking, Attendance and other issues.
