

PAB Minutes

Report:

1. Drug and Alcohol issues at FRHS – in response to both parent and staff concerns regarding student's use of drugs and alcohol, a presentation will be made in conjunction with TEAM Fort Collins to educate parents on the signs and what resources are available. Possible date is December 8th at 7 pm in the Round House. This will be a Fossil Ridge High School community wide forum. Dr. Cook has requested the drug dogs to come visit FRHS in October.
2. Parking lot – is it possible to slow cars down in the drop off lane by adding speed bumps? Dr. Cook will check with PSD to see.
3. School Improvement Plan: 8 goal areas have been identified. The work of teachers aligns with the work of the District to ensure that the transitional goals are met. The 8 FRHS Goals are: Year's growth in reading, writing and math; increase ACT scores; improve attendance to achieve 95% rate; ensure that FRHS is a safe school; successful completion of our 9-12 transition plan; improve graduation rate and move all students to proficient and advanced. 4. Grade Configuration plan. More hiring of continuing contract teachers will begin in November; freshman academy and housing students together in the North Wing; common early lunch for freshman; full schedule for freshman, common club time at FRHS – maybe Advisory time.

6. Concern with suspicious man on a bike riding the lot 5-6 p.m. on regular bases. Dr. Cook will talk to SRO about this.
7. Why are there not bathrooms at the stadium? Concerned parents will contact Bill Franzen to discuss the issue.
