RE: Alert Information

On September 8, 2009, at 3:42 p.m., Fort Collins Police were notified of attempted child abduction at Glenmore Drive and West Plum Street. A nine year-old female was walking home from Moore Elementary School located at 1905 Orchard Place. The driver of a black two door sporty looking car with tinted windows pulled up next to her and told her to get into his car. The suspect brandished a knife from inside the car while talking to the child. The child took off running and the car was last seen westbound on Plum Street.

The suspect is described as an approximately 20-year-old white male. He has blonde hair, cut in a Mohawk style with shaved sides and bangs. He possibly has a mole on one cheek and a bruise on his chin. He has a tattoo on his left inner forearm of a skull and crossbones. He was wearing a dark tank top with some type of design on the front.

The suspect vehicle is a black two door sporty looking car with tinted windows, a rear spoiler, silver spoke rims and a rear driver's side light broken out. A partial California license plate is 57210.

Fort Collins Police are investigating this incident. Parents are encouraged to talk with their children about how to deal with strangers if they are approached and the importance of reporting any incident to an adult and police immediately.
