

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR YOUTUBE VIDEOS AT SCHOOL

YouTube is ***not*** accessible at PSD schools. If a student wishes to use a video in a presentation, there are steps that need to be done at home to convert the video to a compatible format for use. Failure to follow these steps will result in failure to show the video.

At home:

- 1) Find the video you wish to use in your presentation.
- 2) Copy the URL of the video you want to use.
- 3) Paste the video URL in:

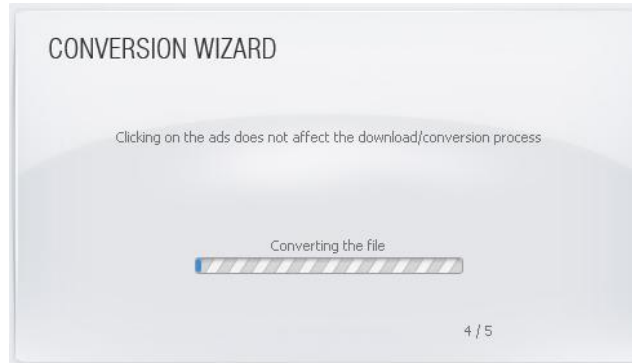

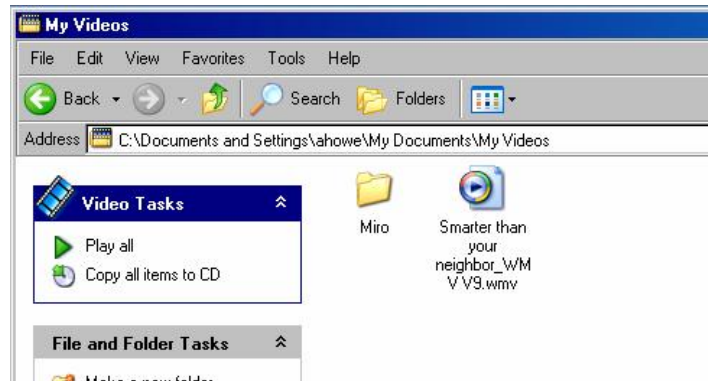

6) The next window will show the video being converted and downloaded to your computer.

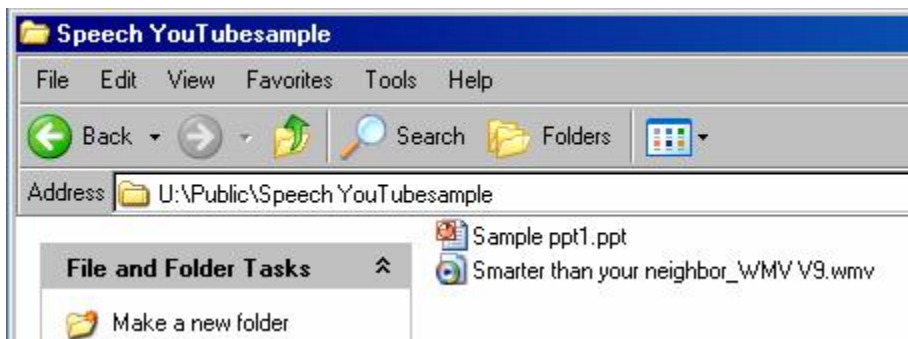


The video will be downloaded to your computer, probably My Videos.
